Flower (Fabric C) 2-3/4"□ 5" x 4-1/4"	C1 C2	2 1	40 20
Leaf (Fabric D) 5"□	D1	2	40

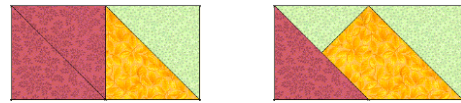


Fast and Furious Flying Geese

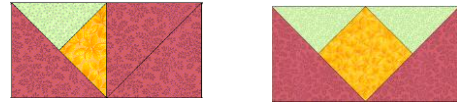
- Draw diagonal line on back of Background 3-1/8"□ (B1).
- Place Background B1 on upper left and lower right of Center 5-3/4"□.
- Sew 1/4" on each side of drawn diagonal line. Cut on diagonal line. Press toward background pieces.
- Place Background B1 on lower left corner of previous units.
- Sew 1/4" on each side of drawn diagonal line. Cut on diagonal line. Press toward background pieces. Unit measures 2-3/4" x 5".
- Each center square plus 4 background squares will make four flying geese units. You should have a total of 20 flying geese units for the quilt.



- Draw diagonal line on back of Flower 2-3/4"□s (C1).



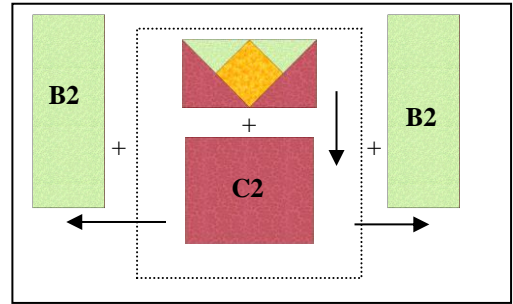
- Add Flower 2-3/4"□ (C1) folded corner to left side of flying geese unit.



- Add Flower 2-3/4"□ (C1) folded corner to right side of previous unit.

- Add Flower 5" x 4-1/4" (C2) to bottom of previous unit.

- Add Background 2-3/4" x 6-1/2" (B2) to right and left of previous unit.



- Draw diagonal lines on back of Flower 5" □.
- Add Leaf 5"□ (D1) folded corner to lower right and left corners.
- Draw diagonal lines on back of Background 2-3/4" □.
- Add Background 2-3/4" □ (B3) folded corner on top of the leaf folded corners to complete block.
- Block should measure 9-1/2" x 6-1/2". Make 20.
